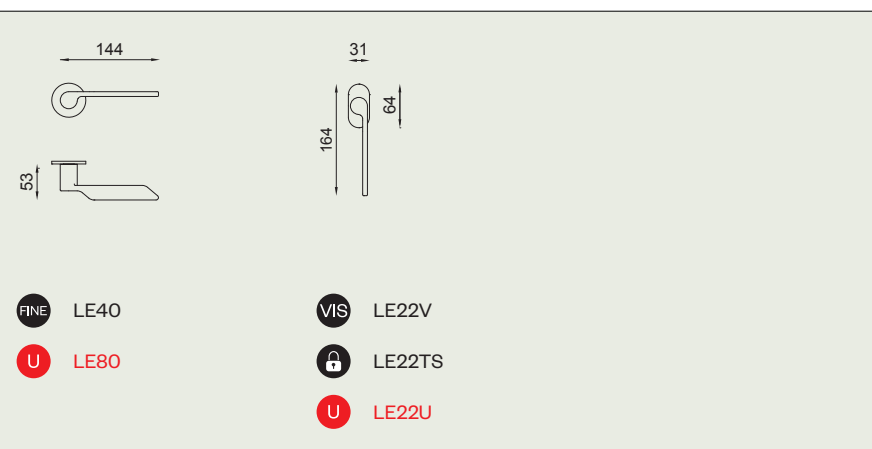

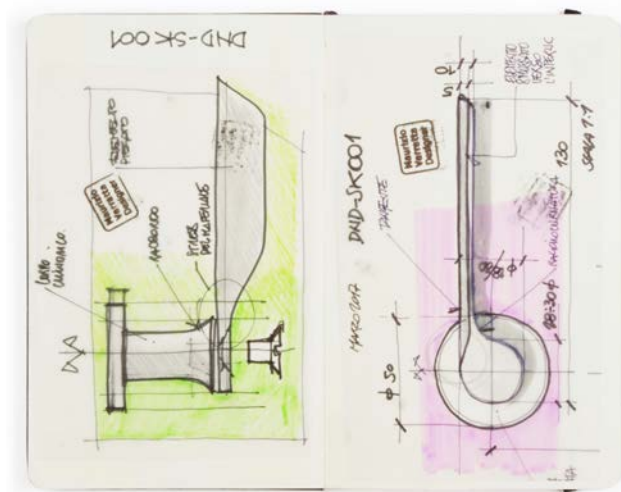
Maurizio Varratta

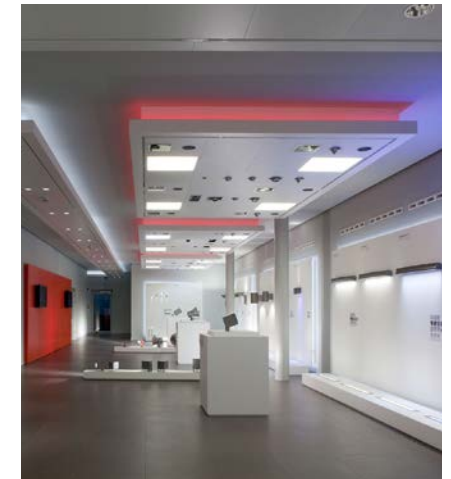
